INCIDENT AT GANESH PANDAL IN SURAT

Sorathiya attack: FIR against 8 BJP leaders

AN FIR was lodged against eight BJP leaders in Surat on a complaint lodged by Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) Gujarat general secretary Manoj Sorathiya who was allegedly assaulted in a clash between AAP and BJP workers at Simada Naka neighbourhood of Surat city Tuesday night while he was inspecting a pandal erected by AAP workers for Ganesh Chaturthi festival.

The AAP accused state BJP of orchestrating an attack on their leader, while BJP spokesperson Rutvij Patel termed AAP as "urban naxals", in a statement on Wednesday.

Sorathiya was admitted to a hospital in Surat with head injuries that required multiple stitches, according to AAP workers. Delhi Chief Minister and AAP national convener Arvind Kejriwal condemned the incident on social media, while AAP Rajya Sabha MPs Raghav Chaddha and Sandeep Pathak arrived in Surat on Wednesday to meet Sorathiya, where they criticised the ruling BJP government in Gujarat.

"It is wrong to attack the opposition members in this manner. Electoral wins and losses keep happening but suppressing the opposition with violence goes against the culture of Gujarat and the people do

not like it. I urge the CM of Gujarat to ensure strict punishment to the culprits and provide safety to all," tweeted Kejriwal Tuesday night.

"I would like to tell the BJP that Arvind Kejriwal and AAP have managed to secure their place in the hearts of the people of Gujarat and the people will take revenge... in the coming elections," said Chaddha, while speaking to reporters at the Surat airport Wednesday.

"Gujarat police and goons of Gujarat belong to the BJP and they are orchestrating attacks on our leaders... why such incidents are not happening against Congress leaders in Gujarat... The reason is that the Congress is not able to pose any chal-

lenge to the BJP in Gujarat," added Chaddha. An FIR was lodged at Kapoda police station in Surat city against eight named accused and other unknown persons under Indian Penal Code (IPC) sections 323 for causing hurt, 324 for causing grievous hurt, 504 for intentional insult, 506 for criminal intimidation as well as under sections of rioting, after Sorathiya filed a complaint.

The named accused are Dinesh Desai (BJP leader and incharge of Kamrej Assembly seat in Surat) and BJP leaders Bharat Galani, Kanti Sagathiya, Bhavesh Ghelani, Kishan Desai, Kalpesh Devani, Mahesh Kadakia and Mahendra Desai. The FIR, however, does not mention the

accused as part of any political party.

According to the complainant by Sorathiya, he went to the Ganesh pandal at Simada Naka around 10 pm, when eight to 10 men approached them. "They yelled at me saying 'tell baldie, why have you come?' They then snatched my glasses and started abusing me saying that they will set the AAP pandal afire. I moved towards the front section of the pandal when these men surrounded me and told each other to kill Manoj 'Takla'. They then hit me with iron rods and wooden sticks... Later, I was taken to a hospital in a 108 ambulance," read Sorathiya's complaint. Talking to The Indian Express, AAP Surat president Rajnikant Vaghani said, "When Manojbhai Sorathiya was guiding us to hang banners behind the pandal, around eight to 10 BJP members and leaders armed with pipes and wooden sticks attacked us. They hit Sorathiya on his head, injuring him severely... The accused later escaped from the spot."

AAP national joint secretary Isudan Gadhi also criticised the attack against Sorathiya and demanded that police lodge an FIR under IPC 307 (attempted murder) against the accused. Police said a cross complaint was registered from both sides, however, only the complaint by Sorathiya has been converted into an FIR.

In his complaint, BJP leader Dinesh Desai alleged that AAP leaders started

the confrontation when they were putting up BJP banners with festival wishes on the roadside railing. "They stopped us from putting up banners as the AAP's Ganesh pandal was beside it and attacked us with wooden sticks," said Desai's complaint.

Talking to The Indian Express, Deputy Commissioner of police Zone 1 Sajansinh Parmar said, "We have deployed police staff at the pandal to prevent such incidents... We have lodged complaint from both the sides and will arrest the accused. The condition of Manoj Sorathiya is stable."

Giving his reactions through a video message, state BJP leader and party co-spokesperson Dr Rutvij Patel said, "The BJP workers were standing at Simada area, when AAP workers came in large numbers and attacked them. BJP leaders Dinesh Desai and Kishan Desai Karshan Sagathiya were injured and they are admitted to Prema hospital in Surat..."

Alleging that the AAP was carrying out violent activities when assembly elections are nearer, Patel added, "It is these very AAP workers and leaders who had come to Kamalam in an inebriated state and teased a woman worker and then had a fight with others... it is the same state president of AAP who hurled shoe on the then state home minister... The people of Gujarat know AAP are urban Naxals and they will never be accepted."

Gujarat ATS arrests two more after 38-kg heroin seizure

Ahmedabad: Days after the Punjab police seized 38 kilograms of heroin from a truck travelling from Kutch to Punjab and arrested two persons, the Gujarat Anti Terrorist Squad (ATS) on Wednesday arrested two more persons from a village in Kutch who allegedly handed the drug consignment to Punjab-based peddlers.

"An ATS team travelled to Lakkhi village to detain the duo who were then brought to the ATS headquarters in Ahmedabad. During primary interrogation, the accused revealed that a Pakistani national named Gul Mohammad handed them the heroin through sea borders in Kutch and they then handed it over to the Punjab-based accused. The two accused from Kutch are being handed over to Punjab police," the officer added. ENS

Luxury developer announces plan to build resort in Gir

JAIPUR-BASED LUXURY resort developer Fine Aceris on Wednesday announced plans to build a resort in Gir as a part of developing destinations in Gujarat.

Addressing a press conference, Rominder Khanna, senior Vice-President (Business Development) at Fine Aceris, said, "For our property in Gir, we are looking at an investment of about Rs 250 crore at the initial stage as it will be a small property. The plans are at a nascent stage... We are yet to finalise the land and seek approval from the Gujarat

government."

Adding that "Gir is a niche destination", Khanna said, "We have to keep in mind environmental laws as well. The development in Gir will be similar to the way we have developed our destination in Jawai dam near Udaipur, Rajasthan."

Dinesh Yadav, founder of Fine Aceris, said that the company has opened its first marketing office in Ahmedabad, its first in Gujarat.

"Ahmedabad will always remain our representative office. We will gradually open other branches in Surat and Vadodara," said Yadav, adding that the firm was trying to attract investment in its upcoming project in Udaipur.
